- LB 455 (*Hallstrom*) Provide for confidentiality of and access to certain injury reports under the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act

- LB 1124 (*Sorrentino*) Increase the cigarette tax and state intent and change provisions relating to the distribution of cigarette tax proceeds

- LB 847 (*Kauth*) Adopt the Nebraska Registered Apprenticeship Act and change provisions relating to the combined tax rate under the Employment Security Law

- LB 1235 (*General Affairs Committee*) Change and transfer provisions of the Nebraska Medical Cannabis Patient Protection Act and the Nebraska Medical Cannabis Regulation Act and provide for taxation
- LB 1155 (*Dorn*) Change provisions relating to legislative oversight

- LB 985 (*DeBoer*) Provide a limitation on the number of individuals for which a guardian or conservator may accept appointment
- LB 835 (*Jacobson*) Change and eliminate provisions relating to fees of the Secretary of State, notices of liens under the Uniform Federal Lien Registration Act and the Uniform State Tax Lien Registration and Enforcement Act, the central filing system, effective financing statements, the master lien list, and filed records under the Uniform Commercial Code
- LB 1205 (*Clouse*) Require the Department of Economic Development to award grants under the Business Innovation Act
