## **GENERAL FILE: 2026 COMMITTEE PRIORITY BILLS**

- LB 1101 (*Nebraska Retirement Systems Committee*) Change the amount of the state contribution to the Nebraska Retirement Fund for Judges
- LB 967 (*Jacobson*) Provide requirements for electronic notice of annual meetings by mutual insurance holding companies

## **SELECT FILE: 2026 COMMITTEE PRIORITY BILLS**

- LB 1001 (*General Affairs Committee*) Change and eliminate provisions relating to licensed racetrack enclosures, licenses and wagering on horseracing, assistance to problem gamblers, bingo, gift enterprises, the Nebraska Commission on Problem Gambling, the Charitable Gaming Division of the Department of Revenue, keno at licensed racetrack enclosures, and the Compulsive Gamblers Assistance Fund
- LB 1001A (*Holdcroft*) Appropriation Bill
- LB 759 (*Brandt*) Change fees and funding for solid waste management, water wells, livestock regulation, hazardous waste management, clean water regulation, and litter reduction and recycling, change membership of a board, provide penalties and enforcement provisions for geologic storage of carbon dioxide, provide for entry upon property for the Perkins County Canal, correct references to and change jurisdiction of the Department of Water, Energy, and Environment, and require local governments to regulate operation of swimming pools, recreation camps, and mobile home parks
- LB 948 (*Agriculture Committee*) Change provisions of the Plant Protection and Plant Pest Act, change fees under the Pesticide Act, rename and change provisions of the Nebraska Commercial Fertilizer and Soil Conditioner Act, eliminate the Nebraska Poultry and Egg Resources Act, terminate a fund, and eliminate provisions relating to certain associations and societies
- LB 894 (*DeKay*) Change provisions relating to the Grain Dealer Act and the Grain Warehouse Act

## **GENERAL FILE: 2026 COMMITTEE PRIORITY BILLS**

- LB 972 (*Fredrickson*) Change provisions relating to parking spaces for handicapped or disabled persons, the State Boat Act, the Motor Vehicle Registration Act, the Motor Vehicle Operator's License Act, the Motor Vehicle Safety Responsibility Act, and the Nebraska Rules of the Road
- LB 596 (*Sanders*) Change requirements for legal publications and notices required by law
- LB 838 (*Jacobson*) Change provisions relating to the financial exploitation of vulnerable or senior adults

## **GENERAL FILE: 2026 SPEAKER PRIORITY BILLS**

- LB 1181 (*Bosn*) Change provisions relating to the rights of victims of certain crimes

- LB 727     *(Kauth)* Authorize law enforcement agencies to obtain, maintain, and possess epinephrine autoinjectors for use by a law enforcement officer and require training
- LB 1240    *(Murman)* Change provisions relating to state recovery under the achieving a better life experience program
