SELECT FILE: 2026 COMMITTEE PRIORITY BILLS

- LB 901 *(Revenue Committee)* Adopt the Domestic Violence and Human Trafficking Service Providers Tax Credit Act, change provisions related to the confidentiality of shared information, the distribution of certain tax revenue, contracts between the Tax Commissioner and collection agencies, the collection and enforcement of delinquent income tax claims, and the Mechanical Amusement Device Tax Act, provide for fees, eliminate certain personal property and sales and use tax exemptions and a tax credit, and change provisions relating to the Nebraska Advantage Research and Development Act and the ImagiNE Nebraska Act
- LB 838 *(Jacobson)* Change provisions relating to the financial exploitation of vulnerable or senior adults, rules and codes of procedure, decedents' estates, inheritance taxes, deceptive trade practices, the Age-Appropriate Online Design Code Act, the Equipment Business Regulation Act, the Nebraska Money Transmitters Act, and the Nebraska Uniform Trust Code and provide for rounding of certain cash transaction amounts

SELECT FILE: 2026 SENATOR PRIORITY BILLS

- LB 768 *(Dover)* Provide powers for the Nebraska Investment Finance Authority and change provisions relating to the Nebraska Affordable Housing Act, the Rural Workforce Housing Investment Act, and the Middle Income Workforce Housing Investment Act
- LB 1067 *(Hallstrom)* Change provisions relating to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund, the rate and disbursement of the documentary stamp tax, the Rural Workforce Housing Investment Fund, and the Middle Income Workforce Housing Investment Fund

GENERAL FILE: 2026 SENATOR PRIORITY BILLS

- LB 1261 *(DeKay, at the request of the Governor)* Prohibit the use of eminent domain to acquire certain privately owned electric generation facilities
- LB 933 *(Cavanaugh, J.)* Provide immunity for health care practitioners under the Nebraska Medical Cannabis Patient Protection Act

GENERAL FILE: 2026 COMMITTEE PRIORITY BILLS

- LB 1114 *(Urban Affairs Committee)* Change provisions related to eligibility of redevelopment plans for expedited review under the Community Development Law
- LB 921 *(Ibach)* Adopt the Nebraska Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act and change certain employer duties under the Non-English-Speaking Workers Protection Act

GENERAL FILE: 2026 SENATOR PRIORITY BILLS

- LB 525 *(Jacobson, at the request of the Governor)* Adopt the Agricultural Data Privacy Act
- LB 1212 *(Riepe)* Provide for licensure of internationally trained physicians under the Uniform Credentialing Act
- LB 815 *(Brandt)* Provide for a tax on diesel fuels, change provisions relating to refunds for motor fuel taxes and the petroleum release remedial action fee, change and eliminate provisions of the Ethanol Development Act, and eliminate the Ethanol Production Incentive Cash Fund
