CONSENT CALENDAR

The following rules apply to Consent Calendar:

- 1) If any five members of the Legislature object to the bill being considered on Consent Calendar, please advise the Clerk in writing. Such requests must be filed with the Clerk prior to the reading of the bill, at this stage of consideration, on the bill to be removed.
- 2) Upon either the completion of debate or the expiration of 15 minutes, whichever comes first, a vote shall be taken to advance the bill and on any pending motions or amendments pursuant to Rule 5, Section 6(d).
- 3) Any amendment adopted, other than the standing committee amendment, which adds new subject matter to the bill will result in the bill not being scheduled at the next stage of debate.

- LB 904 (*Arch*) Change provisions relating to Chinese military companies under the Nebraska Political Accountability and Disclosure Act

- LB 829 (*Lonowski*) Change provisions relating to audit examinations by the Auditor of Public Accounts
- LB 1253 (*Bostar*) Change provisions relating to the laws that apply to certain tax sale certificates

- LB 1055 (*DeBoer*) Provide training requirements for an adult protective services official under the Adult Protective Services Act
- LB 788 (*Bosn*) Change the administrator of the Financial Fraud Victims' Reimbursement Fund from the Attorney General to the Nebraska State Patrol
- LB 913 (*Guereca*) Require the Department of Health and Human Services to appoint a dementia services coordinator
- LB 784 (*Hallstrom*) Change residency requirements for sheriffs in certain counties, requirements for uniforms for sheriffs and deputies, and continuing education requirements for law enforcement officers
- LB 977 (*Storer*) Provide requirements under the Nebraska Rules of the Road for motorists and electric personal assistive mobility device operators encountering certain animals being led, herded, or driven on or along highways

- LB 905 *(Arch)* Change and eliminate provisions relating to boards, commissions, committees, task forces, and funds that terminate
- LB 781 *(Ballard)* Adopt updates to federal law relating to motor vehicles and motor carriers and change civil penalties against certain motor carriers
- LB 986 *(Bostar)* Allow expenditure of campaign funds for security services and systems under the Nebraska Political Accountability and Disclosure Act
- LB 955 *(Hardin)* Provide for practice agreements between pharmacists and physician assistants

- LB 921 *(Ibach)* Adopt the Nebraska Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act and change certain employer duties under the Non-English-Speaking Workers Protection Act
- LB 867 *(Health and Human Services Committee)* Change and eliminate provisions relating to programs and services administered by the Department of Health and Human Services
- LB 1075 *(Sanders)* Provide requirements for certain village warrants, change various provisions of the Election Act, and change election provisions for exceeding a school district's property tax authority

- LB 525 *(Jacobson, at the request of the Governor)* Adopt the Agricultural Data Privacy Act
- LB 1212 *(Riepe)* Provide for licensure of internationally trained physicians under the Uniform Credentialing Act
- LB 815 *(Brandt)* Provide for a tax on diesel fuels, change provisions relating to refunds for motor fuel taxes and the petroleum release remedial action fee, change and eliminate provisions of the Ethanol Development Act, and eliminate the Ethanol Production Incentive Cash Fund
