SELECT FILE: 2026 COMMITTEE PRIORITY BILLS

- LB 967 (*Jacobson*) Change provisions relating to insurance fees, licensing, and trade practices, pharmacy benefit managers, mutual insurance holding companies, the Population Health Information Act, the Health Information Technology Board, and the Site and Building Development Act and adopt the Nebraska Protection of Seniors from Insurance Exploitation Act
- LB 847 (*Kauth*) Adopt the Nebraska Registered Apprenticeship Act, change provisions relating to funds, child labor, the Business Innovation Act, the Contractor Registration Act, the Employee Classification Act, the Employment Security Law, and the Nebraska Wage Payment and Collection Act, and transfer administration of student internships to the Department of Labor

GENERAL FILE: 2026 SENATOR PRIORITY BILLS

- LB 525 (*Jacobson, at the request of the Governor*) Adopt the Agricultural Data Privacy Act
- LB 1212 (*Riepe*) Provide for licensure of internationally trained physicians under the Uniform Credentialing Act
- LB 815 (*Brandt*) Provide for a tax on diesel fuels, change provisions relating to refunds for motor fuel taxes and the petroleum release remedial action fee, change and eliminate provisions of the Ethanol Development Act, and eliminate the Ethanol Production Incentive Cash Fund

GENERAL FILE: 2026 SPEAKER PRIORITY BILLS

- LB 1029 (*Conrad*) Redefine terms relating to reportable funding from a foreign adversarial source for colleges and universities
- LB 764 (*Holdcroft*) Provide for certain Department of Correctional Services employees to be law enforcement officers
- LB 1057 (*Ballard*) Redefine adult day service under the Health Care Facility Licensure Act
- LB 852 (*Spivey*) Provide for the recapture of funding distributed from the Convention Center Support Fund to certain recipients

- LB 935 (*Bosn*) Provide for the award of costs and attorney's fees in certain actions involving political subdivisions
