- LB 60 *(Quick)* Eliminate the restriction on selling a lottery ticket through a vending or dispensing device under the State Lottery Act
- LB 212 *(Wordekemper)* Change tax provisions relating to cigars, cheroots, and stogies
- LR 18CA *(Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee)* Constitutional amendment to require the Legislature to reimburse political subdivisions
- LB 207 *(von Gillern)* Provide a registration fee under the Motor Vehicle Registration Act for certain commercially registered alternative fuel vehicles
- LB 463 *(Ballard)* Require school districts to develop a cardiac emergency response plan under the School Safety and Security Reporting Act and provide for grants for such plans from the Medicaid Managed Care Excess Profit Fund

- LB 668 *(Storer)* Change provisions relating to the Adult Protective Services Central Registry, the central registry of child protection cases, and child welfare case managers
- LB 518 *(Juarez)* Change requirements for a report by the Department of Correctional Services and Board of Parole
- LB 365 *(Quick)* Require coverage of self-measure blood pressure monitoring services under the Medical Assistance Act
- LB 400 *(Wordekemper)* Provide for compensation under the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act for cancers experienced by firefighters

- LB 417 *(Bostar)* Provide for administration of the Nebraska Promise Program by the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska, adopt the College Promise Act, and change provisions relating to the Quality Education Accountability Act
- LB 653 *(Murman)* Change provisions relating to reimbursement for special education programs, support services, and the enrollment option program, provide reimbursement for certain students under the enrollment option program, and change the authorized uses of the Education Future Fund
- LB 203 *(Kauth)* Change powers and duties of health directors in certain local public health departments
- LB 437 *(Riepe)* Repeal the Nebraska Health Care Certificate of Need Act
- LB 110 *(Hughes)* Provide requirements for pelvic examinations
