Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1057 amends §71-404 of the Health Care Facility Licensure Act which defines "adult day service", a daytime care program serving four or more adults who need help due to age or disability. The bill redefines this term to narrow who is excluded from that definition. Previously, any service provided under the Developmental Disabilities Services Act was excluded. Now, only providers that are officially certified as a specialized program offering community-based waiver services under that Act are excluded. PACE centers remain excluded under both the old and new language. LB 1057 contains an emergency clause.
