**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB1127, introduced by Senator Dover, amends sections 37-438, 37-440, and 37-443 of the Game Law to authorize the Game and Parks Commission, beginning January 1, 2027, to issue an optional motor vehicle hangtag park permit for Nebraskans purchasing a resident annual park permit.

The hangtag may be transferred between motor vehicles registered by the permit holder in the state of Nebraska. The hangtag may not be reproduced or replaced; however, a duplicate may be purchased for a convenience fee to be established by the Commission not to exceed \$15. The bill provides that hangtag permits may be procured from the central and district offices of the commission and at other designated areas.
