Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 279 changes the requirements for license plate display on a motor vehicle or trailer to at least one plate prominently displayed in contrast with the current requirement of two plates or a paid fee.

Section 1 - Amends section 60-399 - Number of plates

Alters the requirement that motor vehicles display the 'proper number of plates' to 'at least one license plate'.

Section 2 - Amends section 60-3,100 - License plate issuance

Only one plate is required to be displayed on the back of a motor vehicle or trailer.
