Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 290 requires that additional grant funding from the Economic Recovery and Incentives Division be given for the development of a business park located within or adjacent to one or more qualified census tracts located within the boundaries of an inland port district located within a city of the metropolitan class. Grant funds shall not be used in the downtown area or northern downtown area of a city of the metropolitan class.

These new provisions replace the requirement of being within two miles of a major airport.
