**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB371 amends the Uniform Civil Remedies for Unauthorized Disclosure of Intimate Images Act to include computer-generated or digitally manipulated images. The Act prohibits the disclosure of intimate images without consent and provides a uniform remedy for victims and a defense for disclosers.

Section 1: Amends § 25-3502, which contains defined terms for purposes of the Uniform Civil Remedies for Unauthorized Disclosure of Intimate Images Act, to add computer-generated or digitally manipulated images.

Section 2: Amends § 25-3503, which covers civil actions related to the unauthorized disclosure or threatened disclosure of private intimate images of individuals without their consent, to add computer-generated or digitally manipulated images without the depicted individual's consent to the definition of "private." The private nature of the image is an element in causes of action under this section.

Section 3: Repealer.
