Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB379 proposes to amend Section 68-1724 of the Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2024, by substituting the existing eligibility duration for cash assistance from a maximum of sixty (60) months to a maximum of twenty-four (24) months.

Explanation of amendments:

AM378 amends LB379 by revising the maximum eligibility duration for cash assistance from twenty-four (24) months to thirty-six (36) months.
