**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 429 creates a new statutory section to establish restrictions on school board interactions with professional employees' organizations. The bill defines professional employees' organizations and school employees and requires school boards to provide equal access to physical and electronic mailboxes, meetings, events, and recruitment opportunities when such access is granted to any professional employees' organization. The bill further requires equal treatment with respect to signage and informational materials displayed on school property and prohibits school boards from naming or referring to any day or break in the school calendar using the name of a professional employees' organization.
