**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 722 changes the definitions of "adult with serious mental illness", and "landlord risk mitigation payment" and defines "substance use disorder".

The definition of adult with serious mental illness is changed to not include a diagnosis with a DSM v-code unless such condition exists concurrently with a diagnosable serious mental illness.

Substance use disorder is added to the definition of landlord risk mitigation payment.

Substance use disorder is defined as having the same meaning as defined in Nebraska Revised Statutes 71-430 which is a medical illness caused by repeat misuse of a substance or substances, characterized by clinically significant impairments in health, social function, and impaired control over substance use and diagnosed through assessing cognitive, behavioral, and psychological symptoms. Substance use disorders range from mild to severe
