**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 741 adds members to the Racial Profiling Advisory Committee and the Nebraska Children's Commission. Section (1) of the bill amends Neb. Rev. Stat. § 20-506 to add the chairperson of the Commission on African American Affairs or his or her designee to the Racial Profiling Advisory Committee. Section (2) amends Neb. Rev. Stat. § 43-4202 to add one individual from a list of 3 nominees submitted by the Commission on African American Affairs as a voting member on the Nebraska Children's Commission.
