Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 745 amends 79-730 of the Revised Statutes of Nebraska to revise eligibility requirements for obtaining a high school equivalency diploma. The bill removes the minimum age requirement and the requirement that an individual's graduating class have been graduated for at least one year.
