**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

This bill proposes changes to twenty-eight sections of statute relating to state personnel compensation and the use of Deferred Building Renewal Act funding for federal facilities under the control of the Military Department. It also proposes repealing outright Neb. Rev. Stat. § 83-380, which requires an annual report from the Department of Health and Human Services to the Department of Administrative services and subsequent communications from the DAS director to county clerks.

Sections 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 10, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, and 29 propose changes to sections of statute referring to “monthly” pay and would eliminate the word “monthly” in each affected section of statute.

Sections 4, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, and 22 contain harmonizing references and revisor changes.



Sections 8 and 9 contain proposed changes to two sections of statute relating to the use of Deferred Building Renewal Act funds.

Section 30 contains the partial repealer.

Section 31 would repeal outright Neb. Rev. Stat. § 83-380.

**Explanation of amendments:**

AM 2362 eliminates original changes to payroll periods, retains provisions relating to federal facilities under control of the state military department, and eliminates a report from DHHS.

Section 1 is original section 4, harmonizing a statutory reference.

Section 2 is original section 8 relating to federal facilities.

Section 3 is original section 9 relating to federal facilities.

Sections 4 through 15 harmonize statutory references.

Section 16 contains the partial repealer.

Section 17 outright repeals § 83-380 requiring a regular report relating to county monies due to DHHS.
