Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would revise provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 69-1311 relating to annual notice given by the State Treasurer of persons whose unclaimed property is in the custody of the Treasurer and eligible for return. It would remove a requirement that this annual notice list every such person by name in local newspapers near their last known address, and would instead mandate that the annual notice include information about how to search for unclaimed property held by the Treasurer.
