Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill proposes changes to three sections of statute from the Engineers and Architects Regulation Act.

Section 1 would revise Neb. Rev. Stat. § 81-3437.01 to provide that when applying a seal to a document, the date of the seal's application be placed across or adjacent to the seal in such a manner as to not obscure the licensee's name or license number.

Section 2 would revise Neb. Rev. Stat. § 81-3449 to delete provisions relating to nonresident certification holders.

Section 3 would revise Neb. Rev. Stat. § 81-3451 to reorganize and modify the requirements for licensure as a professional engineer.



Section 4 contains the partial repealer.
