Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would move language in Neb. Rev. Stat. § 49-1480 to a new section of law within the Political Accountability and Disclosure Act. The substance of the statutory language relates to the registration of persons engaged in "influencing activities" for Chinese military companies. This change would clarify that the registrations required under the law are to be filed with the Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure Commission and not with the Clerk of the Legislature.
