Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill proposes the elimination or consolidation of a number of state boards and commissions.

It would eliminate the Nebraska Potato Development Committee along with an associated fund.

It would eliminate the Climate Assessment Response Committee.

It would eliminate the Nebraska Aquaculture Board.

It would eliminate the Board of Alcohol and Drug Counseling and move its duties to the Board of Mental Health Practice.

It would eliminate the Foster Care Reimbursement Rate Committee and the Bridge to Independence Advisory Committee and transfer their duties to the Nebraska Children's Commission.



It would eliminate the Board of Examiners of County Highway and City Street Superintendents and transfer its duties to the Board of Public Roads Classifications and Standards.

The bill proposes elimination of 39 inactive funds and lapsing of money therein into the General Fund.

Finally, the bill proposes modification to three other funds including the Information Management Revolving Fund, Vacant Building and Excess Land Cash Fund, and the Nebraska Capital Construction Fund.

The bill also contains a number of harmonizing changes.
