Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 936 allows a medical radiographer to use fluoroscopy in collaboration with a nurse practitioner. In addition, education and training requirements are provided.

SECTION BY SECTION SUMMARY:

Sec. 1: Amends Section 38-1915 to allow a medical radiographer to utilize fluoroscopy under the direction of, or in collaboration with, a nurse practitioner. Also, the term "conjunction" is removed and replaced with the term "collaboration" in cases when a medical radiographer is using fluoroscopy with a certified registered anesthetist.



Sec. 2: Amends Section 38-2315 to allow a nurse practitioner to perform and utilize fluoroscopy for procedural guidance and for the performance of authorized duties upon the successful completion of appropriate education and training as approved jointly by the Department of Health and Human Services and the Board of Advanced Practice Registered Nurses. Such education and training shall be in accordance with rules and regulations adopted and promulgated pursuant to Section 71-3508. Also, a nurse practitioner may direct fluoroscopy in collaboration with a licensed medical radiographer.
