Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 952 restructures several court-related cash funds, eliminates obsolete transfer provisions, and terminates the Court Appointed Special Advocate grant fund framework.

Specifically, the bill creates the Supreme Court Operations Cash Fund for court and probation programs; terminates the Supreme Court Reports Cash Fund and transfers remaining funds to the General Fund; removes outdated transfer provisions from the Commission on Public Advocacy Operations Cash Fund statute; terminates the Court Appointed Special Advocate Fund and transfers remaining funds to the General Fund; changes the citation of the Court Appointed Special Advocate Act to harmonize provisions due to the outright repealed sections; and outright repeals §§ 43-3719 and 43-3720, which govern Court Appointed Special Advocate grant administration.
