No Fiscal Impact

The current staffing pattern allows the Agriculture, Natural Resources, Transportation & Telecommunications Committees to have a Legal Counsel or Research Analyst. Changing the Transportation & Telecommunications Committee to the Transportation Committee would not affect its staffing pattern and they would retain the Legal Counsel or Research Analyst position. Combining the Agriculture and Natural Resources Committees would eliminate one of these positions. However, creating the Telecommunications & Technology Committee would absorb that position resulting in a zero financial impact.
