Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill creates a new pharmacy license type for automated medication systems. DHHS indicates the cost to implement one new license types costs \$10,000 in FY27 only from the Professional and Occupational Licensing Fund. Additionally, pharmacy inspectors would also require training on the changes which can be absorbed within current agency appropriations. The bill sets the fee of the new license type at \$50. There is no estimate of the number of automated medication systems the new license type would apply to therefore the estimate of revenue is indeterminable.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB1211 expands the Automated Medication Systems Act to create a license type for an automated medication system which is located on property either owned or leased by a licensed pharmacy.

LB1211 will require the Occupational Licensure Unit to create a new license type within the existing license issuance system, update existing regulations to include pharmacy operated automated medication systems, and update Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) webpages. Pharmacy inspectors will also need to be trained on the statutory requirements for this new license.

This new license must be added to the existing license issuance system, which will cost an estimated \$10,000 to the system's vendor.

LB1211 sets the fee for the new license at \$50 for both initial licensure and annual renewal. This fee is intended to cover the costs associated with implementing the license. The expected revenue from this fee is difficult to predict as the number of pharmacies that use these systems is not tracked.
