LB271 adds a new section to Nebraska's criminal code to prohibit interference with railroad infrastructure, equipment, and personnel, specifically criminalizing any unauthorized tampering with or damage to railroad tracks, communication systems, or other related facilities, and covering actions like detaching or disabling trains, assaulting railroad employees, interfering with rail signals, and placing hazardous substances near rail lines. Anyone who knowingly or recklessly commits these acts, or conspires or threatens to do so, would be guilty of a Class IIIA felony.

The Supreme Court has stated that LB 271 will have a minimal fiscal impact and will not require any additional resources.
