Explanation of Estimate:

LB292 authorizes the Department of Economic Development (DED) to award a grant for conducting a comprehensive statewide study on prefabricated housing. The study is intended to evaluate zoning and regulatory barriers, infrastructure and utility considerations, financing and capital availability, current market supply and demand, and potential incentives related to prefabricated housing in Nebraska. The legislation contains intent language to appropriate \$500,000 from the Middle Income Workforce Housing Investment Fund to DED to fund the grant for the study.

LB292 would require the report issued by the grantee to be completed by April 1, 2026.

Based on the current language, DED can complete the tasks necessary to undertake the grant with current resources.
