LB390 would require each school board of a public school district to adopt a policy relating to access by a parent, guardian, or educational decisionmaker to certain school library information.

Beginning with the 2026-27 school year, each school board's policy will:

- require the creation of an online catalog of all books in the district's library, categorized by school building, which will be accessible for viewing by a parent, guardian, or educational decisionmaker of a student attending that district
- provide the opportunity for a parent, guardian, or educational decisionmaker of a student to be notified when the student of that parent, guardian, or educational decisionmaker checks out a book from the school library by means of a website or application notification or by opting in to email notifications. Those notifications will include:
 - o the title of the book checked out by the student
 - o the name of the author of the book checked out by the student
 - o the date the book checked out by the student is due to be returned to the school library

AM97 eliminates the requirement to have an online catalog & will only require the creation a catalog of all books in the district's library.

LB390 requires each school district to adopt a policy pertaining to access to school library materials. AM97 eliminates the requirement for the catalogue of all books to be online, and the underlying bill continues to require the opportunity for an educational decisionmaker to be notified when a student checks out a book from the library. The removal of the requirement for software should reduce the cost to schools significantly, and there should continue to be no cost to the NDE.
