Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB390 would require each school board of a public school district to adopt a policy relating to access by a parent, guardian, or educational decisionmaker to certain school library information.

Beginning with the 2026-27 school year, each school board's policy will:

- require the creation of an online catalog of all books in the district's library, categorized by school building, which will be accessible for viewing by a parent, guardian, or educational decisionmaker of a student attending that district
- provide the opportunity for a parent, guardian, or educational decisionmaker of a student to be notified when the student of that parent, guardian, or educational decisionmaker checks out a book from the school library by means of a website or application notification or by opting in to email notifications. Those notifications will include:
  - the title of the book checked out by the student
  - o the name of the author of the book checked out by the student
  - the date the book checked out by the student is due to be returned to the school library

AM97 eliminates the requirement to have an online catalog & will only require the creation a catalog of all books in the district's library.

AM653 adds that provisions established in LB390 will only apply to a school library that is located on school district property & will not apply to any other public library regardless if that library contracts with a school district for use by their students.
