AM2444 would strike sections 1 to 10 of the standing committee amendments, AM2221, and replace them with new provisions adopting the Agricultural Data Privacy Act.

The amendment provides that agricultural producers own and control agricultural data originating from their farms, land, devices, or equipment; prohibits the sale of such data without the producer's express written consent; requires certain contract language and data security protections; authorizes enforcement by the Attorney General; and adds agricultural data to the records that may be withheld from public disclosure under section 84-712.05.

The amendment also adopts the Conversational Artificial Intelligence Safety Act, which establishes disclosure requirements for conversational artificial intelligence services, provides safeguards for minor users, requires protocols for responses to self-harm prompts, and authorizes enforcement by the Attorney General. In addition, AM2444 amends section 84-712.05 and repeals the original version of that section. The bill further provides that civil penalties collected under the Conversational Artificial Intelligence Safety Act shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for distribution in accordance with the Constitution.

The Supreme Court states that minimal fiscal impact is anticipated and that no additional resources are required. The Attorney General estimates no fiscal impact. There is no basis to disagree with these estimates.
