Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 539 amends handgun regulations in Nebraska by eliminating handgun purchase reporting requirements of the Nebraska State Patrol and the Department of Health and Human Services. It also streamlines criminal history checks, focusing them specifically on qualifications for concealed carry permits or identifying disqualifications under state or federal law, relying primarily on federal background checks instead of state-issued certificates.

The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) states that the total fiscal impact cannot yet be determined due to insufficient data on potential case numbers and new users. Any additional work required to plan changes and update ECRA manuals will be handled by current staff.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB539 repeals and amends statutes to harmonize language relating to handgun, firearm, or explosive purchases or permits and the approval or disqualification process by the Nebraska State Patrol (NSP). This process includes checking information collected in the Division of Behavioral Health’s Electronic Commitment Reporting Application (ECRA) as submitted by the courts and moved through an interface with NSP to the FBI’s National Instant Criminal Background System (NICS). LB539 maintains the Department database requirements and the provision of specific information to NSP regarding persons committed for mental health treatment.

The total fiscal impact to the Department of Health and Human Services cannot be determined at this time due to the lack of quantifiable data on the number of cases and users that may be added. Any time worked towards scoping the changes and revising manuals for ECRA will be absorbed by current staff.
