As amended, this bill permits referral of families with a child two years old or younger to evidence-based home visitation services by a case manager and families with a child three years of age or younger to early intervention services. Because the bill is permissive there is no fiscal impact to the Department of Health and Human Services.

Additionally the bill repeals Nebraska Revised Statute § 68-2306 which excludes single or infrequent home visits from the Family Home Visitation Act. This repeal allows for single home visits to qualify under the Act. There is no fiscal impact to this change.
