- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to health care; to adopt the 340B Contract
- 2 Pharmacy Protection Act; to provide severability; and to declare an
- 3 emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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- 1 Section 1. Sections 1 to 5 of this act shall be known and may be
- 2 <u>cited as the 340B Contract Pharmacy Protection Act.</u>
- 3 Sec. 2. For purposes of the 340B Contract Pharmacy Protection Act:
- 4 (1) 340B drug means a drug that a 340B entity may purchase at a
- 5 reduced price pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 256b, as such section existed on
- 6 January 1, 2025;
- 7 (2) 340B entity means a covered entity as defined in 42 U.S.C.
- 8 <u>256b(a)(4)</u>, as such section existed on January 1, 2025; and
- 9 (3) Manufacturer has the same meaning as in section 71-7438.
- 10 Sec. 3. (1) Any manufacturer, agent or affiliate of such
- 11 manufacturer, or third-party logistics provider of such manufacturer's
- 12 <u>drugs shall not, either directly or indirectly, deny, restrict, or</u>
- 13 prohibit the acquisition of any 340B drug by or delivery of any 340B drug
- 14 to any location authorized by any 340B entity to receive such 340B drug,
- 15 unless receipt of such 340B drug is prohibited by federal law.
- 16 (2) Any manufacturer, agent or affiliate of such manufacturer, or
- 17 third-party logistics provider shall not, either directly or indirectly,
- 18 require any 340B entity to submit any data, including any claim data,
- 19 <u>utilization data, encounter data, medical data, purchasing data, or other</u>
- 20 <u>data, as a condition for allowing the acquisition of any 340B drug by or</u>
- 21 delivery of any 340B drug to any 340B entity or to any location
- 22 authorized by any 340B entity to receive such 340B drug, unless such data
- 23 is required by federal law.
- 24 Sec. 4. The Attorney General or any county attorney may institute
- 25 an action in the name of the State of Nebraska for an injunction or other
- 26 process to restrain or prevent any violation of the 340B Contract
- 27 <u>Pharmacy Protection Act.</u>
- Sec. 5. Nothing in the 340B Contract Pharmacy Protection Act shall
- 29 <u>be construed or applied to conflict with federal law or any other law of</u>
- 30 the State of Nebraska, if such law is compatible with applicable federal
- 31 <u>law.</u>

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1 Sec. 6. If any section in this act or any part of any section is

- 2 declared invalid or unconstitutional, the declaration shall not affect
- 3 the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions.
- 4 **Sec. 7.** Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 5 passed and approved according to law.
