- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to require each school board of a
- 2 public school district to adopt a policy relating to access by a
- 3 parent, guardian, or educational decisionmaker to certain school
- 4 library information.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 **Section 1.** (1) For purposes of this section, educational
- 2 <u>decisionmaker has the same meaning as in section 79-530.</u>
- 3 (2) Each school board of a public school district shall adopt a
- 4 policy for implementation at the beginning of the 2026-27 school year,
- 5 <u>relating to the rights of a parent, guardian, or educational</u>
- 6 decisionmaker to access school library materials. Such policy shall:
- 7 (a) Require the creation of a catalog of all books in the school
- 8 <u>district's library, categorized by school building, which shall be</u>
- 9 accessible for viewing by a parent, guardian, or educational
- 10 decisionmaker of a student attending such school district; and
- 11 <u>(b) Provide the opportunity for a parent, guardian, or educational</u>
- 12 <u>decisionmaker of a student to be notified when the student of such</u>
- 13 parent, guardian, or educational decisionmaker checks out a book from the
- 14 <u>school library by means of a website or application notification or by</u>
- 15 opting in to email notifications. Such notification shall include:
- (i) The title of the book checked out by the student;
- 17 (ii) The name of the author of the book checked out by the student;
- 18 and
- 19 (iii) The date the book checked out by the student is due to be
- 20 returned to the school library.
- 21 (3) This section shall only apply to a school library that is
- 22 located on school district property and shall not apply to any other
- 23 <u>public library regardless if such library contracts with a school</u>
- 24 district for use by students.
