- The Director of Administrative Services is hereby 3 Sec. 5.
- 4 authorized and directed to draw his or her warrants upon the funds in the
- state treasury enumerated in this act, in favor of the several 5
- beneficiaries named in this act for the amount set opposite their 6
- 7 respective names, upon the presentation of proper vouchers therefor. The
- 8 several amounts appropriated in this act shall be in full payment of any
- and all claims, rights, causes of action, damages, and demands of every 9
- 10 character and kind owing by or against the State of Nebraska, its
- 11 officers, agents, and employees, and their successors and assigns with
- 12 respect to each of the beneficiaries respectively in whose favor the
- appropriations are made. The director shall not deliver any warrant for 13
- 14 any items appropriated in this act until a receipt and release in full,
- releasing the State of Nebraska, its officers, employees, and agents, and 15
- 16 their successors and assigns, has been filed by each of the beneficiaries
- 17 respectively. Upon presentation of the warrants, the State Treasurer is
- hereby directed to pay the same out of money in the General Fund or out 18
- 19 of money in other funds indicated in this act not otherwise appropriated.
