4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. (1) There is created within the Department of
2	Environment and Energy the Office of Climate Action. The office shall
3	work with interested stakeholders in climate action, political
4	subdivisions, and organizations supporting climate action across this
5	state to enhance education and skills, provide technical support, and
6	expand access to resources to support climate action. The office shall
7	serve as a point of contact to assist with policies and programs dealing
8	with climate action.
9	<u>(2) The Office of Climate Action shall employ personnel to create</u>
10	policies that support climate action and fulfill the duties of the
11	<u>office.</u>
12	<u>(3) On or before July 1, 2026, the Office of Climate Action shall</u>
13	create a climate action plan that shall propose actions to:
14	<u>(a) Manage the risks of climate change impacts on the state; and</u>
15	(b) Reduce the causes of climate change within the state.
16	(4) On or before July 1 of each year, the Office of Climate Action
17	<u>shall file with the Clerk of the Legislature an annual report that</u>
18	<u>details:</u>
19	<u>(a) The extent to which state legislation enacted the prior year</u>
20	supports, hinders, or affects climate action;
21	(b) The amount of federal dollars secured for climate action across
22	<u>this state;</u>
23	<u>(c) Any technical assistance provided by the Office of Climate</u>
24	Action to stakeholders, political subdivisions, and organizations;
25	<u>(d) The number of times the Office of Climate Action collaborated</u>
26	with stakeholders, political subdivisions, and organizations;
27	<u>(e) A synopsis of localized climate action plans and programs; and</u>
28	<u>(f) Any recommendation for additional climate action through</u>
29	<u>investment or activities.</u>
30	<u>(5) For the purposes of this section, climate action means any</u>
31	effort to combat climate change and its effects.
