Section 1. Section 38-2037, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 38-2037 (1) In addition to the grounds for disciplinary action found
- 4 in sections 38-178 and 38-179, a license to practice medicine and surgery
- 5 or osteopathic medicine and surgery or a license to practice as a
- 6 physician assistant may be denied, refused renewal, limited, revoked, or
- 7 suspended or have other disciplinary measures taken against it in
- 8 accordance with section 38-196 when the applicant or licensee fails to
- 9 comply with the provisions of section 71-603.01, 71-604, 71-605, or
- 10 71-606 relating to the signing of birth and death certificates.
- 11 (2) It is the intent of the Legislature to ensure the protection of
- 12 the rights under the First Amendment to the Constitution of the United
- 13 States for individuals licensed to practice medicine and surgery or
- 14 <u>osteopathic medicine and surgery by providing for the public expression</u>
- 15 of differing medical opinions and allowing such opinions to be subjected
- 16 to the scrutiny of public and professional forums. A license to practice
- 17 medicine and surgery or osteopathic medicine and surgery shall not be
- 18 subject to any disciplinary measures as a result of the applicant or
- 19 <u>licensee expressing an opinion in a public or professional forum.</u>
