Section 1. Section 50-1301, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 50-1301 (1) The Legislature finds that state government actions have
- 4 produced an increase in the numbers of boards, commissions, and similar
- 5 entities that support, advise, direct, or administer various state
- 6 programs. The process has evolved without sufficient legislative and
- 7 executive oversight and without a system of checks and balances. Because
- 8 the Legislature is responsible for the expenditure of public money and
- 9 the shaping of the administration of state government and is held
- 10 accountable for fiscal policy, the Legislature should also be responsible
- 11 for the termination, continuation, or modification of such boards,
- 12 commissions, and similar entities so that it may be assured that its
- 13 directives have been faithfully carried out.
- 14 (2) The Legislature further finds that boards, commissions, and
- 15 similar entities cannot function as intended when vacancies on the board,
- 16 commission, or similar entity are left unfilled. Membership on these
- 17 <u>entities is often required by statute to be appointed by either the</u>
- 18 Governor or the Legislature. In the case of a gubernatorial appointment
- 19 for a seat that has been vacant for six months or more, the legislative
- 20 committee of jurisdiction may take applications for the seat and forward
- 21 recommendations to the Governor for possible appointment. If the seat
- 22 remains vacant for another three months after the date recommendations
- 23 <u>are forwarded to the Governor, the Executive Board of the Legislative</u>
- 24 <u>Council may make the appointment.</u>
- 25 Sec. 2. Original section 50-1301, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 26 Nebraska, is repealed.
