- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. (1) For purposes of this section:
2	<u>(a) Cybersecurity event means an event resulting in unauthorized</u>
3	access to, or disruption or misuse of, an information system or nonpublic
4	information stored on an information system;
5	(b) Information system means:
6	(i) A discrete set of electronic information resources organized for
7	the collection, processing, maintenance, use, sharing, dissemination, or
8	disposition of electronic nonpublic information; or
9	<u>(ii) A specialized system, including an industrial or process</u>
10	control system, a telephone switching and private branch exchange system,
11	and an environmental control system;
12	(c) Nonpublic information means information that is not publicly
13	available and concerns a person that, because of a name, number, personal
14	mark, or other identifier, can be used to identify such person, in
15	combination with the following:
16	<u>(i) A social security number;</u>
17	(ii) A driver's license number or state identification card number;
18	(iii) A financial account number or credit or debit card number;
19	(iv) A security code, access code, or password that would permit
20	access to such person's financial accounts; or
21	<u>(v) Any biometric record;</u>
22	<u>(d) Private entity means a corporation, religious or charitable</u>
23	organization, association, partnership, limited liability company,
24	limited liability partnership, or other private business entity, whether
25	organized for-profit or not-for-profit; and
26	<u>(e) Publicly available information means information that is</u>
27	lawfully made available through federal, state, or local government
28	records or information that a private entity has a reasonable basis to
29	believe is lawfully made available to the general public.
30	(2) A private entity shall not be liable in a class action resulting
31	from a cybersecurity event unless the cybersecurity event was caused by

1 willful, wanton, or gross negligence on the part of the private entity.
