- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to amend sections 79-1001,
- 2 79-1017.01, 79-1022, 79-1022.02, 79-1023, 79-1027, and 79-1031.01,
- 3 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for military impact
- 4 funding and change provisions relating to local system formula
- 5 resources and certain certification dates under the Tax Equity and
- 6 Educational Opportunities Support Act; to harmonize provisions; to
- 7 repeal the original sections; and to declare an emergency.
- 8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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Section 1. Section 79-1001, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 79-1001 Sections 79-1001 to 79-1033 and section 2 of this act shall
- 4 be known and may be cited as the Tax Equity and Educational Opportunities
- 5 Support Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. (1) For school fiscal year 2025-26 and each school fiscal
- 7 year thereafter, the department shall determine the military impact
- 8 <u>funding to be paid to each school district in accordance with this</u>
- 9 <u>section</u>.
- 10 (2) A district shall receive military impact funding in an amount
- 11 <u>calculated pursuant to subsection (3) of this section if the district</u>
- 12 <u>received a basic support payment of federal impact aid under section 7003</u>
- 13 of the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 in the
- 14 school fiscal year immediately preceding the school fiscal year for which
- 15 the aid is to be calculated and the district provides free public
- 16 education to federally connected children whose parents are on active
- 17 duty in the uniformed services.
- 18 (3) For purposes of the calculation of military impact funding
- 19 pursuant to this section:
- 20 <u>(a) Per-pupil federal impact aid amount means the amount calculated</u>
- 21 by dividing (i) the amount the district received as a basic support
- 22 payment of federal impact aid under section 7003 of the federal
- 23 Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 in the school fiscal year
- 24 immediately preceding the school fiscal year for which the aid is to be
- 25 calculated by (ii) the number of federally connected children whose
- 26 parents are on active duty in the uniformed services actually enrolled in
- 27 <u>the district as of the day of the fall membership count pursuant to</u>
- 28 <u>section 79-528; and</u>
- 29 (b) Per-pupil general fund tax levy means the amount calculated by
- 30 dividing (i) the total local property tax levy receipts of such district
- 31 from the preceding school fiscal year by (ii) the fall membership of such

- 1 district, without the inclusion of federally connected children whose
- 2 parents are on active duty in the uniformed services and who otherwise
- 3 are included in the calculation of the fall membership.
- 4 (4)(a) The amount of military impact funding provided to a district
- 5 shall be calculated by (i) subtracting the per-pupil federal impact aid
- 6 from the per-pupil general fund tax levy and (ii) multiplying the amount
- 7 <u>calculated in subdivision (a)(i) of this subsection by the number of</u>
- 8 federally connected children whose parents are on active duty in the
- 9 <u>uniformed services actually enrolled in the district as of the day of the</u>
- 10 fall membership count pursuant to section 79-528.
- 11 (b) A district's military impact funding shall be zero if the amount
- 12 calculated pursuant to subdivision (4)(a)(i) produces a negative result.

- 16 prior to school fiscal year 2023-24, local system formula resources
- 17 includes other actual receipts determined pursuant to section 79-1018.01,
- 18 net option funding determined pursuant to section 79-1009, allocated
- 19 income tax funds determined pursuant to section 79-1005.01, and community
- 20 achievement plan aid determined pursuant to section 79-1005, and is
- 21 reduced by amounts paid by the district in the most recently available
- 22 complete data year as property tax refunds pursuant to or in the manner
- 23 prescribed by section 77-1736.06.
- 24 (2) For state aid calculated for school fiscal <u>years</u> year 2023-24
- 25 and 2024-25 each school fiscal year thereafter, local system formula
- 26 resources includes other actual receipts determined pursuant to section
- 27 79-1018.01, net option funding determined pursuant to section 79-1009,
- 28 allocated income tax funds determined pursuant to section 79-1005.01,
- 29 community achievement plan aid determined pursuant to section 79-1005,
- 30 and a percentage of foundation aid determined pursuant to section
- 31 79-1006, and is reduced by amounts paid by the district in the most

- 1 recently available complete data year as property tax refunds pursuant to
- 2 or in the manner prescribed by section 77-1736.06.
- 3 (3) For state aid calculated for school fiscal year 2025-26 and each
- 4 school fiscal year thereafter, local system formula resources includes
- 5 other actual receipts determined pursuant to section 79-1018.01, net
- 6 option funding determined pursuant to section 79-1009, allocated income
- 7 tax funds determined pursuant to section 79-1005.01, community
- 8 <u>achievement plan aid determined pursuant to section 79-1005, a percentage</u>
- 9 of foundation aid determined pursuant to section 79-1006, and military
- 10 <u>impact funding pursuant to section 2 of this act, and is reduced by</u>
- 11 amounts paid by the district in the most recently available complete data
- 12 <u>year as property tax refunds pursuant to or in the manner prescribed by</u>
- 13 <u>section 77-1736.06.</u>
- 14 Sec. 4. Section 79-1022, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 15 amended to read:
- 16 79-1022 (1) On or before June 15, 2025 2023, and on or before March
- 17 1 of each year thereafter, the department shall determine the amounts to
- 18 be distributed to each local system for the ensuing school fiscal year
- 19 pursuant to the Tax Equity and Educational Opportunities Support Act and
- 20 shall certify the amounts to the Director of Administrative Services, the
- 21 Auditor of Public Accounts, and each local system. On or before June 15,
- 22 <u>2025</u> 2023, and on or before March 1 of each year thereafter, the
- 23 department shall report the necessary funding level for the ensuing
- 24 school fiscal year to the Governor, the Appropriations Committee of the
- 25 Legislature, and the Education Committee of the Legislature. The report
- 26 submitted to the committees of the Legislature shall be submitted
- 27 electronically. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection,
- 28 certified state aid amounts, including adjustments pursuant to section
- 29 79-1065.02, shall be shown as budgeted non-property-tax receipts and
- 30 deducted prior to calculating the property tax request in the local
- 31 system's general fund budget statement as provided to the Auditor of

- 1 Public Accounts pursuant to section 79-1024.
- 2 (2) Except as provided in this subsection, subsection (8) of section
- 3 79-1016, and sections 79-1005, 79-1033, and 79-1065.02, the amounts
- 4 certified pursuant to subsection (1) of this section shall be distributed
- 5 in ten as nearly as possible equal payments on the last business day of
- 6 each month beginning in September of each ensuing school fiscal year and
- 7 ending in June of the following year, except that when a local system is
- 8 to receive a monthly payment of less than one thousand dollars, such
- 9 payment shall be one lump-sum payment on the last business day of
- 10 December during the ensuing school fiscal year.

- 16 applicable allowable reserve percentages pursuant to section 79-1027
- 17 completed prior to <u>the effective date of this act</u> June 1, 2023, for
- 18 school fiscal year 2025-26 2023-24 are null and void.
- 19 Sec. 6. Section 79-1023, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 20 amended to read:
- 21 79-1023 (1) On or before June 15, 2025 2023, and on or before March
- 22 1 of each year thereafter, the department shall determine and certify to
- 23 each school district budget authority for the general fund budget of
- 24 expenditures for the ensuing school fiscal year.
- 25 (2) Except as provided in sections 79-1028.01, 79-1029, 79-1030, and
- 26 81-829.51, each school district shall have budget authority for the
- 27 general fund budget of expenditures equal to the greater of (a) the
- 28 general fund budget of expenditures for the immediately preceding school
- 29 fiscal year minus exclusions pursuant to subsection (1) of section
- 30 79-1028.01 for such school fiscal year with the difference increased by
- 31 the basic allowable growth rate for the school fiscal year for which

1 budget authority is being calculated, (b) the general fund budget of expenditures for the immediately preceding school fiscal year minus 2 exclusions pursuant to subsection (1) of section 79-1028.01 for such 3 school fiscal year with the difference increased by an amount equal to 4 any student growth adjustment calculated for the school fiscal year for 5 which budget authority is being calculated, or (c) one hundred ten 6 percent of formula need for the school fiscal year for which budget 7 8 authority is being calculated minus the special education budget of expenditures as filed on the school district budget statement on or 9 before September 30 for the immediately preceding school fiscal year, 10 which special education budget of expenditures is increased by the basic 11 allowable growth rate for the school fiscal year for which budget 12 authority is being calculated. 13

- 14 (3) For any school fiscal year for which the budget authority for
 15 the general fund budget of expenditures for a school district is based on
 16 a student growth adjustment, the budget authority for the general fund
 17 budget of expenditures for such school district shall be adjusted in
 18 future years to reflect any student growth adjustment corrections related
 19 to such student growth adjustment.
- Sec. 7. Section 79-1027, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 79-1027 No district shall adopt a budget, which includes total requirements of depreciation funds, necessary employee benefit fund cash reserves, and necessary general fund cash reserves, exceeding the applicable allowable reserve percentages of total general fund budget of expenditures as specified in the schedule set forth in this section.

- 7 Each district with combined necessary general fund cash reserves,
- 8 total requirements of depreciation funds, and necessary employee benefit
- 9 fund cash reserves less than the applicable allowable reserve percentage
- 10 specified in this section may, notwithstanding the district's applicable
- 11 allowable growth rate, increase its necessary general fund cash reserves
- 12 such that the total necessary general fund cash reserves, total
- 13 requirements of depreciation funds, and necessary employee benefit fund
- 14 cash reserves do not exceed such applicable allowable reserve percentage.
- 15 Sec. 8. Section 79-1031.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 16 amended to read:
- 17 79-1031.01 The Appropriations Committee of the Legislature shall
- 18 annually include the amount necessary to fund the state aid that will be
- 19 certified to school districts on or before June 15, 2025 2023, and on or
- 20 before March 1 of each year thereafter for each ensuing school fiscal
- 21 year in its recommendations to the Legislature to carry out the
- 22 requirements of the Tax Equity and Educational Opportunities Support Act.
- 23 Sec. 9. Original sections 79-1001, 79-1017.01, 79-1022, 79-1022.02,
- 24 79-1023, 79-1027, and 79-1031.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
- 25 are repealed.
- 26 **Sec. 10.** Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 27 passed and approved according to law.
