4 for certain certificated intrastate motor carriers, certain motor
5 carriers transporting household goods, and any motor carrier
6 transporting employees of a railroad carrier; and to repeal the

7 original section.

8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 75-307, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
 2024, is amended to read:

75-307 (1) Certificated intrastate motor carriers, including common 3 4 and contract carriers, any motor carrier transporting household goods 5 under a license issued pursuant to section 75-304.03, and any motor carrier transporting employees of a railroad carrier under a license 6 7 issued pursuant to section 75-304.04 shall comply with reasonable rules and regulations prescribed by the commission governing the filing with 8 9 the commission, the approval of the filings, and the maintenance of proof at such carrier's principal place of business of surety bonds, policies 10 of insurance, qualifications as a self-insurer, or other securities or 11 agreements, in such reasonable amount as required by the commission, 12 13 conditioned to pay, within the amount of such surety bonds, policies of 14 insurance, qualifications as a self-insurer, or other securities or agreements, any final judgment recovered against such motor carrier for 15 bodily injuries to or the death of any person resulting from the 16 17 negligent operation, maintenance, or use of motor vehicles under such certificate, permit, or license or for loss or damage to property of 18 19 others. No certificate or permit shall be issued to a common or contract carrier, no license shall be issued to a motor carrier transporting 20 household goods under section 75-304.03 or employees of a railroad 21 carrier under section 75-304.04, nor shall such certificate, permit, or 22 23 license remain in force unless such carrier complies with this section and the rules and regulations prescribed by the commission pursuant to 24 25 this section.

(2) The commission may, in its discretion and under its rules and regulations, require any certificated carrier, any motor carrier transporting household goods under a license issued pursuant to section 75-304.03, and any motor carrier transporting employees of a railroad carrier under a license issued pursuant to section 75-304.04 to file a surety bond, policies of insurance, qualifications as a self-insurer, or

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1 other securities or agreements, in a sum to be determined by the 2 commission, to be conditioned upon such carrier making compensation to 3 shippers or consignees for all property belonging to shippers or 4 consignees and coming into the possession of such carrier in connection 5 with its transportation service. Any carrier which may be required by law to compensate a shipper or consignee for any loss, damage, or default for 6 7 which a connecting motor common carrier is legally responsible shall be subrogated to the rights of such shipper or consignee under any such 8 9 bond, policies of insurance, or other securities or agreements to the extent of the sum so paid. 10

11 (3) When setting the rates for required policies of insurance 12 pursuant to this section, the commission shall require at least a minimum 13 of one million dollars in uninsured and underinsured insurance coverage 14 per occupant.

15 <u>(4)</u> (3) In carrying out this section, the commission may classify 16 motor carriers and regulated motor carriers taking into consideration the 17 hazards of the operations of such carriers and the value of the household 18 goods carried. Nothing contained in this section shall be construed to 19 authorize the commission to compel motor carriers other than those 20 transporting household goods under section 75-309 or under a license 21 issued pursuant to section 75-304.03 to carry cargo insurance.

22 (5) (4) This section does not apply to transportation network
 23 companies.
