- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to vital statistics; to amend section 71-602,
- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change requirements
- 3 relating to standard forms and release of health data and
- 4 statistical research information; and to repeal the original
- 5 section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 71-602, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 71-602 (1) The department shall adopt and promulgate rules and regulations prescribing all standard forms for registering with or 4 5 reporting to the department and for certification to the public of any birth, abortion, marriage, annulment, dissolution of marriage, or death 6 7 registered in Nebraska. Such forms shall (a) provide for the registration of vital events as accurately as possible, (b) secure information about 8 9 the economic, educational, occupational, and sociological backgrounds of 10 the individuals involved in the registered events and their parents as a basis for statistical research or quality improvement in order to reduce 11 morbidity and mortality and improve the quality of life, (c) accomplish 12 13 such duties in a manner which will be uniform with forms for reporting similar events which have been established by the United States Public 14 Health Service to the extent such forms are consistent with state law, 15 16 and (d) permit other deviations from such forms as will reduce the costs 17 of gathering information, increase efficiency, or protect the health and safety of the people of Nebraska without jeopardizing such uniformity. 18

19 (2) All information designated by the department on all certificates as being for health data and statistical research shall be confidential 20 and may be released only to the United States Public Health Service or 21 its successor, government health agencies, statewide quality improvement 22 23 <u>initiatives</u>, or a researcher <u>utilizing a clear and expedient application</u> 24 process, as approved by the department in accordance with its rules and 25 regulations. The department shall may publish at least annually on its website analyses of any information received on the forms for scientific 26 and public health purposes in such a manner as to assure that the 27 28 identity of any individual cannot be ascertained. The release of such information pursuant this section shall not 29 to make otherwise confidential information a public record. 30
