- 2 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2024; to change
- 3 judges' salaries; to provide an operative date; to repeal the
- 4 original section; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 2 Supplement, 2024, is amended to read:
- 3 24-201.01 On July 1, 2022, the salary of the Chief Justice and the
- 4 judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred ninety-eight thousand
- 5 four hundred twenty-six dollars and fifty-one cents. On July 1, 2023, the
- 6 salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be
- 7 two hundred twelve thousand three hundred sixteen dollars and thirty-
- 8 seven cents. On July 1, 2024, the salary of the Chief Justice and the
- 9 judges of the Supreme Court shall be two hundred twenty-five thousand
- 10 fifty-five dollars and thirty-five cents. On July 1, 2025, the salary of
- 11 <u>the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be two</u>
- 12 <u>hundred thirty-four thousand fifty-seven dollars and fifty-six cents. On</u>
- 13 July 1, 2026, the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the
- 14 Supreme Court shall be two hundred forty-three thousand four hundred
- 15 nineteen dollars and eighty-seven cents.
- 16 The Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall hold no
- 17 other public office of profit or trust during their terms of office nor
- 18 accept any public appointment or employment under the authority of the
- 19 government of the United States for which they receive compensation for
- 20 their services. Such salaries shall be payable in equal monthly
- 21 installments.
- 22 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes operative on July 1, 2025.
- 23 Sec. 3. Original section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 24 Supplement, 2024, is repealed.
- 25 **Sec. 4.** Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 26 passed and approved according to law.
