- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Pharmacy Practice Act; to amend section
- 2 38-28,104, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2024; to provide
- 3 requirements for certain prescription refills as prescribed; and to
- 4 repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 38-28,104, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 2 Supplement, 2024, is amended to read:
- 3 38-28,104 (1) A prescription for a legend drug which is not a
- 4 controlled substance must contain the following information prior to
- 5 being filled by a pharmacist or a practitioner who holds a pharmacy
- 6 license under subdivision (1) of section 38-2850: Patient's name, or if
- 7 not issued for a specific patient, the words "for emergency use" or "for
- 8 use in immunizations"; name of the drug, device, or biological; strength
- 9 of the drug or biological, if applicable; dosage form of the drug or
- 10 biological; quantity of drug, device, or biological prescribed; number of
- 11 authorized refills; directions for use; date of issuance; prescribing
- 12 practitioner's name; and if the prescription is written, prescribing
- 13 practitioner's signature. Prescriptions for controlled substances must
- meet the requirements of sections 28-414 and 28-414.01.
- 15 (2) If a pharmacist receives a request for a prescription refill
- 16 <u>with no refill authorization and the pharmacist is unable to readily</u>
- 17 <u>obtain refill authorization from the prescribing practitioner, the</u>
- 18 pharmacist may dispense an emergency refill of no more than a thirty-day
- 19 supply of the prescription, or the amount dispensed on the most recent
- 20 <u>refill, whichever is less, if:</u>
- 21 (a) The pharmacist obtains prescription information from: (i) A
- 22 prescription label; (ii) a prescription record located in any pharmacy;
- 23 or (iii) a common database;
- 24 (b) The prescription refill is not for a controlled substance;
- 25 (c) The prescription refill is for a maintenance medication; and
- 26 (d) In the pharmacist's professional judgment, the interruption of
- 27 <u>therapy may produce undesirable consequences or may be detrimental to the</u>
- 28 patient's welfare and cause physical or mental discomfort.
