Section 83-4,114.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of 2 Nebraska, is amended to read: 83-4,114.02 (1) Before disciplinary measures are taken against an 3 inmate for drug or alcohol violations, an inmate may request and the 4 department shall provide independent confirmation testing of positive 5 6 results of: 7 (a) Urinalysis urinalysis testing; or -8 (b) Any screening test, field test, presumptive test, or spot test 9 of an item suspected of being or containing a contraband drug. (2) If the confirmation test remains positive, the inmate may be 10 required to pay the cost of the confirmation test. 11 12 Sec. 2.
