- Section 1. The intent of the Legislature is to support pregnant
- 2 people and not criminalize pregnancy or punish people for their pregnancy
- 3 <u>outcomes or for their decisions relating to their pregnancy.</u>
- 4 Sec. 2. A person shall not be cited, arrested, or prosecuted for
- 5 any offense relating to the outcome of such person's own pregnancy,
- 6 including experiencing a stillbirth or miscarriage, the intentional
- 7 <u>termination of a pregnancy, or any other pregnancy outcome that does not</u>
- 8 <u>result in a live birth.</u>
- 9 **Sec. 3.** A person shall be immune from any civil action if such
- 10 <u>action is based upon the pregnancy outcome of such person's own</u>
- 11 pregnancy, including experiencing a stillbirth or miscarriage, the
- 12 <u>intentional termination of a pregnancy, or any other pregnancy outcome</u>
- 13 <u>that does not result in a live birth.</u>
