1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to building codes; to amend section 58-701, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 72-805, Revised 2 3 Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2024; to provide on exception to the 4 requirement that buildings constructed with state funds comply with 5 the 2018 International Energy Conservation Code; to prohibit the 6 Department of Economic Development from requiring certain projects 7 receiving funding from the Affordable Housing Trust Fund comply with 8 the International Energy Conservation Code as prescribed; harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original sections. 9

10 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

**Section 1.** Section 58-701, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 8 of section 72-805 related to complying with the International Energy
- 9 Conservation Code and obtaining approval of building plans and
- 10 specifications by the Department of Environment and Energy.

- 12 2024, is amended to read:
- 13 72-805 Except as provided in section 2 of this act for certain
- 14 projects funded by the Affordable Housing Trust Fund, the The 2018
- 15 International Energy Conservation Code, published by the International
- 16 Code Council, applies to all new buildings constructed in whole or in
- 17 part with state funds after July 1, 2020. The Department of Environment
- 18 and Energy shall review building plans and specifications necessary to
- 19 determine whether a building will meet the requirements of this section.
- 20 The department shall provide a copy of its review to the agency receiving
- 21 funding. The agency receiving the funding shall verify that the building
- 22 as constructed meets or exceeds the code. The verification shall be
- 23 provided to the department. The Director of Environment and Energy may,
- 24 in consultation with the State Building Administrator of the Department
- 25 of Administrative Services, adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to
- 26 carry out this section.
