- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to economic development; to adopt the
 Manufacturing Modernization Pilot Investment Act; and to declare an
 emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. Sections 1 to 8 of this act shall be known and may be
2	cited as the Manufacturing Modernization Pilot Investment Act.
3	Sec. 2. The purpose of the Manufacturing Modernization Pilot
4	Investment Act is to partner with the manufacturing sector by providing
5	one-time grants to eligible manufacturing operations to assist such
6	operations with capital investments in qualified investments that will
7	increase, and lead to the adoption and integration of, smart technologies
8	and increased productivity in existing manufacturing operations located
9	in this state and that will provide a positive economic impact in the
10	<u>State of Nebraska.</u>
11	Sec. 3. For purposes of the Manufacturing Modernization Pilot
12	<u>Investment Act:</u>
13	(1) Department means the Department of Economic Development;
14	(2) Eligible manufacturing operation means a manufacturer of goods
15	at a facility located in this state that:
16	<u>(a) Has a North American Industry Classification System number</u>
17	within the manufacturing sector range of 31 to 33;
18	<u>(b) Has been an established business for a minimum of three years</u>
19	prior to the date of application for the grant;
20	<u>(c) Derives a minimum of fifty-one percent of the manufacturer's</u>
21	gross revenue from the sale of manufactured goods;
22	(d) Employs a minimum of three full-time employees; and
23	<u>(e) Demonstrates the ability to provide private matching financial</u>
24	support for the manufacturer's manufacturing modernization investment
25	<u>project on a one-to-one basis;</u>
26	<u>(3) Grant means a manufacturing modernization investment grant</u>
27	issued under the Manufacturing Modernization Pilot Investment Act in an
28	<u>amount up to, but not to exceed, two hundred fifty thousand dollars from</u>
29	the Manufacturing Modernization Pilot Investment Fund;
30	(4) Manufacturing modernization investment project means a project
31	that is intended to lead to the adoption and integration of smart

1	technologies into existing manufacturing operations located in the state
2	by mitigating the risk to the manufacturer of significant technology
3	investments. Manufacturing modernization investment project includes, but
4	is not limited to, an investment in specialized hardware, software, or
5	other equipment intended to assist a manufacturer in increasing the
6	manufacturer's productivity, efficiency, and competitiveness; and
7	<u>(5) Private matching financial support means any financial support</u>
8	derived from a source other than a direct appropriation from the State of
9	<u>Nebraska or its political subdivisions.</u>
10	Sec. 4. (1) Beginning October 1, 2025, through November 1, 2025, an
11	eligible manufacturing operation may apply to the department for a grant.
12	The application shall include, but not be limited to, the following
13	<u>information:</u>
14	<u>(a) A description of the manufacturing modernization investment</u>
15	project;
16	(b) The estimated cost of the manufacturing modernization investment
17	project; and
18	<u>(c) Documentation on the amount of private matching financial</u>
19	support available for the manufacturing modernization investment project
20	that have been received or will be received by the eligible manufacturing
21	operation. Such amount shall be at least equal to the amount of any grant
22	received under the act. The documentation provided under this subdivision
23	does not need to identify any provider of private matching financial
24	<u>support.</u>
25	(2) The department shall consider applications in the order in which
26	they are received. If an applicant is an eligible manufacturing operation
27	and otherwise qualifies for a grant, the department shall, subject to
28	subsection (3) of this section, approve the application and notify the
29	applicant of the approval.
30	(3) The department may approve applications within the limits of
31	available funding under the Manufacturing Modernization Pilot Investment

Act. The amount of any grant approved shall be equal to the amount of 1 2 money supplied by the eligible manufacturing operation from providers of private matching financial support, as documented under subdivision (1) 3 4 (c) of this section, except that no grant shall be for more than two 5 hundred fifty thousand dollars. (1) The department shall not approve an application for a 6 Sec. 5. 7 manufacturing modernization investment project that was commenced prior to the date of the application. 8 9 (2) Any eligible manufacturing operation that no longer meets the 10 requirements of subdivision (2) of section 3 of this act shall repay any grant funds received under the Manufacturing Modernization Pilot 11 12 Investment Act. 13 The Manufacturing Modernization Pilot Investment Fund is Sec. 6. created. The fund shall consist of transfers authorized by the 14 15 Legislature and any gifts, grants, or bequests from any source, including 16 federal, state, public, and private sources. The fund shall be 17 administered by the department and shall be used to provide grants under the Manufacturing Modernization Pilot Investment Act. Any money in the 18 19 fund available for investment shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska 20 21 State Funds Investment Act. 22 It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate [XXXX] Sec. 7. dollars from the General Fund for purposes of carrying out the 23 24 Manufacturing Modernization Pilot Investment Act. 25 Sec. 8. The department may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to carry out the Manufacturing Modernization Pilot Investment 26 27 Act. 28 Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when Sec. 9. passed and approved according to law. 29
