| 10 | notifying the prospective employer of the need to cancel or reschedule |

| 12 | <u>(2) The department shall establish a portal on its website, an email</u> |
| 13 | address, and a telephone hotline for employers to report individuals who |
| 14 | fail to respond to offers of employment or who fail to appear for |
