## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 545**

Introduced by Rountree, 3. Read first time January 22, 2025 Committee: Judiciary

- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to menstrual products; to provide immunity
  from liability for injury or death resulting from the use of donated
  menstrual products as prescribed; and to define terms.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. (1)(a) A person, manufacturer, or distributor shall not
2	be subject to civil or criminal liability arising from the nature, age,
3	packaging, or condition of an apparently usable menstrual product that
4	<u>such person, manufacturer, or distributor donates in good faith to a</u>
5	nonprofit organization for ultimate distribution to an individual in need
6	<u>of such product.</u>
7	<u>(b) A nonprofit organization shall not be subject to civil or</u>
8	criminal liability arising from the nature, age, packaging, or condition
9	of an apparently usable menstrual product that such nonprofit
10	organization received in good faith from a person, manufacturer, or
11	distributor for ultimate distribution to an individual in need of such
12	product.
13	(2) Subsection (1) of this section shall not apply to an act or
14	<u>omission of any person, manufacturer, distributor, or nonprofit</u>
15	organization that constitutes gross negligence or intentional misconduct
16	and results in injury to, or death of, a user or recipient of a menstrual
17	product.
18	(3) For purposes of this section:
19	<u>(a) Apparently usable means, with respect to a menstrual product,</u>
20	that the product meets all quality and labeling standards imposed by
21	federal, state, and local laws and regulations whether or not the product
22	<u>is readily marketable; and</u>
23	<u>(b) Menstrual product means a sanitary napkin, tampon, liner, cup,</u>
24	underwear and any similar item used by an individual for monstruation
